ACTION TAKEN REPORT – FAMT HOSTELS (BOYS & GIRLS)

1. Scheduled Time Slots for Bus Transportation:

- To manage the rush during bus transportation for class attendance, specific time slots have been assigned for students across different academic years and branches.

2. Enhanced Hygiene Measures:

- A dedicated students' committee has been established to supervise and ensure high standards of hygiene and cleanliness within the hostels.
- Regular feedback sessions are conducted bi-weekly to collect input on hygiene standards.
- The committee's observations and feedback will be regularly reviewed, and necessary adjustments will be implemented based on the provided suggestions.

3. Non-Vegetarian Options:

- Despite limitations due to safety concerns, recognizing the demand for non-vegetarian options, the Institute has decided to serve non-vegetarian meals weekly. Special vegetarian options will be provided for those who do not prefer non-vegetarian food.
- Additionally, two servings of eggs per week will be included in the menu, with no extra charges for the hostellers.


4. Menu Variety and Display:

- The committee will ensure the timely display of the menu in advance, allowing hostellers to make informed choices.


5. Window Glass Replacement:
