The Department of Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering conducted two National level Quiz on Outcome Based Education (OBE) and Communication Engineering during the lockdown.

National Level Quiz on Outcome Based Education (OBE): The main aim of the National level quiz on OBE was to sensitize the Engineering faculty about Outcome-Based Education. “Outcome-Based Education” (OBE) model has increasingly being adopted at Engineering colleges in India. It is considered as a giant leap forward to improve the technical education in India and help Indian Engineers compete with their global counterparts.
