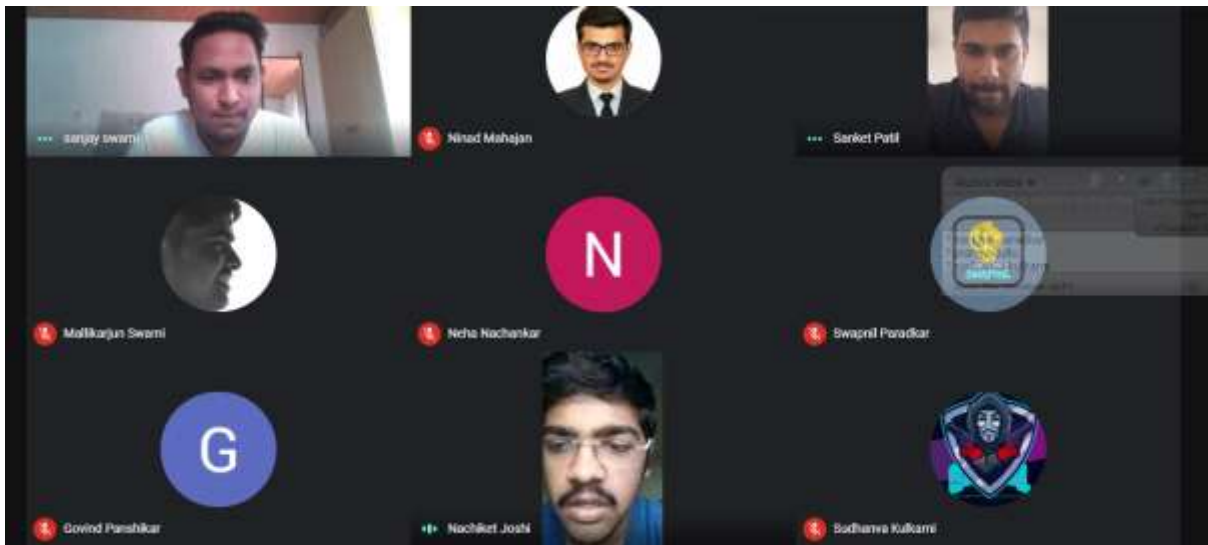
Mr Sanjay Swami, the alumnus of FAMT, has graduated in **Electrical Engineering** and recently has completed **M.Sc. in Mechatronics** with Grade 1.8 from **the University of Siegen, Germany**. His specialization is **Deep Learning**. He has completed his **thesis** in **Carl Zeiss**. During his tenure in FAMT, he actively participated in many extracurricular activities, especially through EESA. He received **Best Student of the Year Award** by **ISTE** for **Maharashtra and Goa section in 2016**.

Mr Sanket Patil, the alumnus of FAMT, has graduated in **Mechanical Engineering**. Presently he is working as **International Trainee** at **Vattenfall**. He has completed **ME Environmental Engineering** with Grade 1.9 from **University of Applied Sciences, Dresden** with the specialization in **Renewable Energy and District Heating System**. 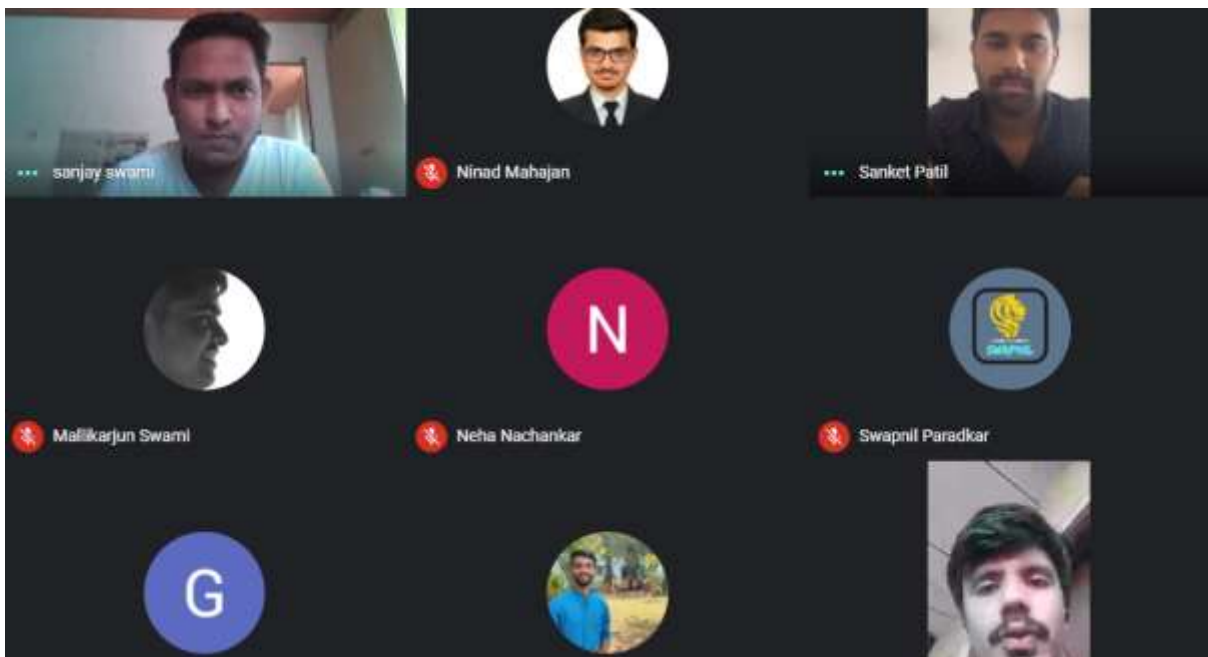
During the sessions, they shared information on various aspects of PG in Germany. Initially, they shared information of examinations like GRE, TOEFEL and ILTS which are mandatory to get admission in Germany and how to prepare for these examinations. They discussed points like how to decide the PG course, Job perspectives, how to search institutes using DAAD website, the application process, preparation of mandatory documents like transcripts and their attestation, passport, visa, SOP, Resume in the German style. Although two openings are available for admission in a year, they advised students to go for Winter Semester as major courses start in winter. Importance of internship during the course was emphasized from the job point of view. Finally, tips were given for visa interview, preparation of SOP, part-time jobs in Germany etc. At the end of the sessions, many students asked their doubts which were elaborately explained by the duo.

The initiative received an excellent response from students of all the branches. Total **218 students** had registered for the web series and **109 students participated** in the discussion. **Prof. M.N.Tagare**, Associate Professor, FAMTAA Incharge, organized these sessions. **Sandeep Kulkarni, BE Electrical** designed the poster for the event.
