
Every engineering student considers Scientific Calculator as an academic lifesaver and EESA took the initiative to give a better understanding of how to use it for various calculations.

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
The lead was then handed over to Ms Vaishnavi Petkar who demonstrated some calculations live on a physical scientific calculator with examples.
