

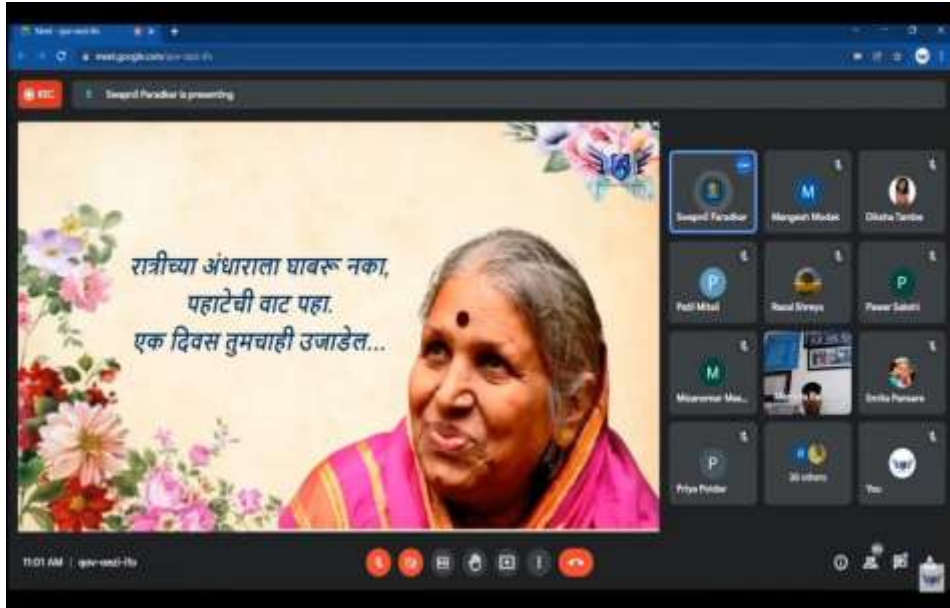

मातृ वदना - A Tribute to Sou. Sindhutai Sapkal

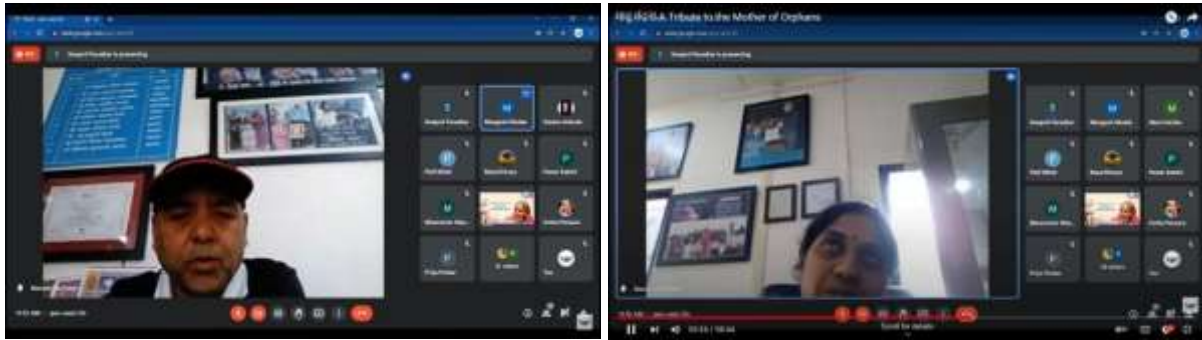

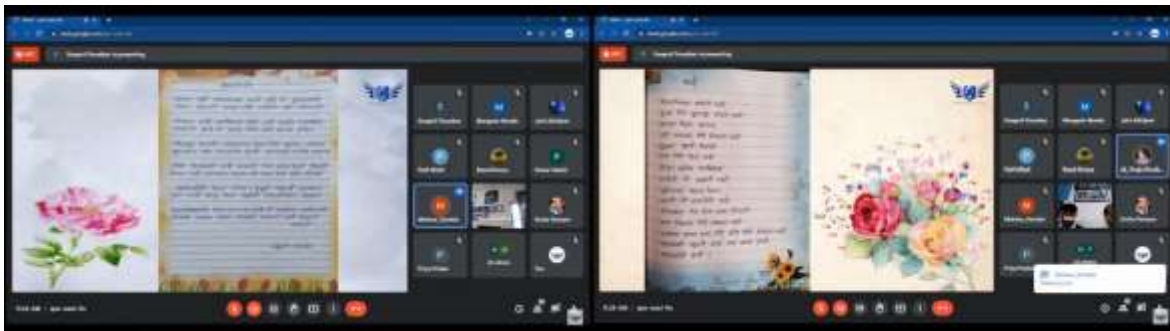
