



ACSES Organized TechVenture 2K24

The Association of Computer Science and Engineering Students (ACSES) organized various technical competitions under the TechFest titled “TechVenture 2K24” on 19th and 20th January 2024.

With a lamp lighting ceremony and blessings from goddess Saraswati, respected principal Dr. K. K. Prasad inaugurated the TechFest on 19th January 2024. The hologram technique inauguration of TechVenture2k24 was witnessed by students and faculty from CSE (AI & ML), students from other departments of FAMT, and the participants from other colleges in and around Ratnagiri. Around 294 students participated in various competitions and they enjoyed all aspects of each competition.

The technical festival provided a platform to all students to showcase their technical skills and also help students develop team building and leadership skills. An organizing committee of students also get an opportunity to learn various management skills which include planning, budgeting, multitasking, time management, creativity etc., that help to execute the event successfully. Events like Code Hunt, and Break the Query were implemented through in-house mobile application and software developed by our students. Talking Robot with one hand motion was designed and developed by SE and TE CSE students earned a lot of praise from all.

In the Code **Hunt** competition, participants have to predict the output of a given code in a given time and that output was the location where the QR Code of the next location had been set. This event encouraged participants to solve coding problems in a fun way. 98 students participated in the Code Hunt competition. In the **Digital Poster-making** competition, participants had to design a digital poster using Figma (open-source tool). This will boost their design skill. 12 students participated in the Digital Poster making competition. 40 participants of the **Break the Query** competition understand the database and learnt ways to frame the query which will provide the required result.

In any programming language debugging plays a vital role in getting the appropriate output. The **Debugging** events helped participants gain confidence to analyse the code and find any faults in that code. 41 students participated in the Debugging competition. The **Google It** competition tested the searching skills of participants to search an accurate information related to an image provided by the committee. 82 students participated in the Google It competition. For those students who wanted to test their typing and keyboard skills, we had a **Blindfold Typing** competition. The two-day event was successfully conducted by the ACSES committee members due to their teamwork dedication and proper planning
