Three Days Entrepreneurship Awareness Camp



Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Cell, Finolex Academy of Management and Technology, Ratnagiri organized three days “**Entrepreneurship Awareness Camp**” from 9th to 11th February 2018. It was sponsored by the Department of Science and Technology under the DST-NIMAT project. Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India is an implementing agency under the aegis of National S&T Entrepreneurship Development Board (NSTEDB), Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India.

For this three days camp, 86 students were registered from the institute. To make this camp successful and versatile development of entrepreneurship skills among the students, we invited experienced trainers and speakers from different areas. For practical experience and exposure of industrial practices, we organized student’s industrial visit at Aboobker Ice and cold storage, Mirjole MIDC, Ratnagiri, Maharashtra, an Ice making and storage factory.

Prof Dhammpal Nangare Assistant professor, FAMT, discussed the importance of communication skill required in business persons. Further, Dr S. S. Goilkar, Dean R & D , FAMT, explained the aspect of research and development in business. He gave the information about R & D laboratory, agency which helps the new entrepreneurs. In the last session of the camp, Prof Y A Landge talked about the identification of business opportunities.
