Finolex Academy of Management and Technology organized district level START-UP BOOT CAMP

Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Dept. of Industrial Policy and Promotion), Government of India in collaboration with MSInS (Maharashtra State Innovation Society) Government of Maharashtra organized Startup Boot Camps in 14 districts of Maharashtra as a part of Start-up India Maharashtra Yatra from 3rd October to 3rd November 2018.

Start-up Boot Camp for Ratnagiri district was organized at Finolex Academy of Management and Technology on Monday, 22nd October, 2018.

The aim of this Boot Camp was to provide a platform for budding entrepreneurs for pitching their ideas which can be converted into a business. The inaugural session of this boot camp was held in the presence of Hon.Mr. Sunil Chavan (District Collector, Ratnagiri) as the Chief Guest, Mr. Mithun John (Joint CEO, MSInS), and Dr. Kaushal Prasad (Principal, FAMT).

Dr. Milind S Kirkire (Convener, Start-up Boot Camp), in his welcome address, explained that the aim of this boot camp is to help the budding entrepreneurs to convert their ideas at grass root level into successful business.

Mr. Sunil Chavan said in his address that ideas need incubation; only then innovators will get a boost. Along with incubation, he also emphasized the need of simplification of procedures, governmental support, and efficient training which can convert raw ideas into business. Mr. Mithun John explained the role and functioning of Maharashtra State Innovation Society, a nodal agency of the state for boosting proper ecosystem for startups. In the presidential address,

Dr. Kaushal Prasad said that innovation is translating knowledge into a commercial product. He highlighted the significance of creating a profound knowledge- base that may result into a long term benefit for the nation's progress.

Inaugural session was followed by **ideation workshop** conducted by Mr. Rahul Srivastava where he introduced 'Start-up India' campaign in depth along with basics of ideation.

'Train the Trainers', a parallel session was conducted by Mr. Amitabh Vyas for teachers involved in entrepreneurship development activities, which was aimed at developing an entrepreneurial ecosystem in academic institutions. Various support schemes like Nidhi Prayas, Atal Innovation Mission etc were introduced to the participants.

Besides, a 'Mentor's Talk' was delivered by Mr. Siddhesh Keluskar (Founder of OpenApp: Bangalore basedstartup), alumnus of FAMT. He guided the participants regarding capacity building, self- motivation, systematic efforts required to be a good entrepreneur.

Mr. Santosh Kolte (Director, Kolte Computer Training Centre) delivered an 'Entrepreneur's Talk' in which he shared his experiences in order to motivate and guide upcoming businesspersons.

Approximately 80 teams/ individuals from all corner of Ratnagiri district, Mumbai, Panvel and Kolhapurpitched the innovative business ideas in parallel sessions before MSInS and Singex Experts. Further, 30 best ideas were shortlisted for the grand finale of Start-up Yatra to be held at VNIT Nagpur on 3rd November 2018.
