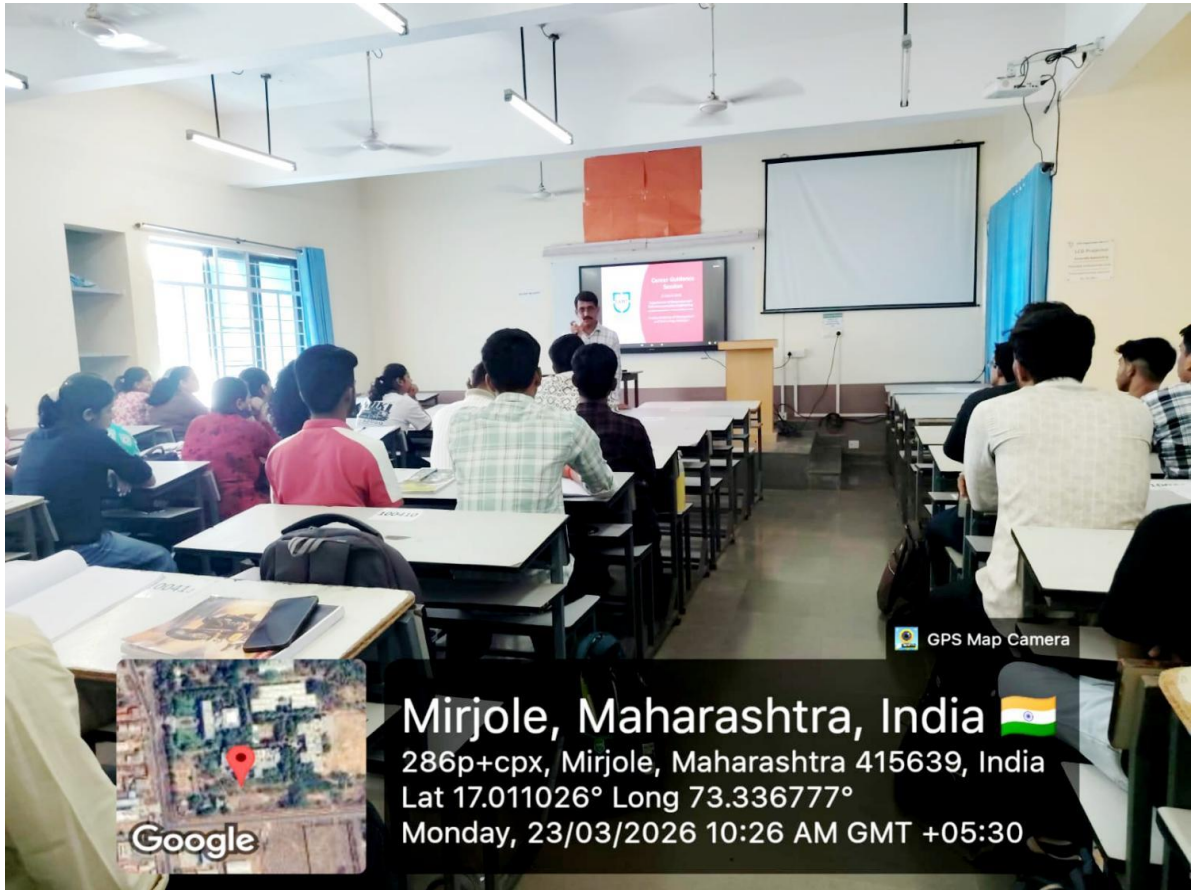
The session was conducted by **Dr. Saurabh S. Athalye**, who provided a comprehensive overview of the **Training & Placement (T&P)** activities at both the college and department levels. He detailed the various career opportunities available specifically for E&TC engineers, including roles in core Electronics, Telecommunications, and IT sectors. Students were also briefed on the different types of recruitment drives they will face in the coming years, ranging from on-campus placements to off-campus pool drives.

A significant portion of the session was dedicated to the "Triad of Employability": **Academic Projects, Internships, and Certifications**. Dr. Athalye emphasized how early involvement in technical projects and obtaining domain-specific certifications significantly enhances a student's professional profile. The session also addressed the importance of lifelong learning and understanding the global impact of engineering roles.

The interactive session saw active participation from **48 students**, who engaged in discussions regarding industry trends and skill development. The event was organized under the **guidance of HoD Dr. Sharada V. Chougule**. This initiative successfully provided students with a clear roadmap for their transition from academic learners to industry-ready professionals.
