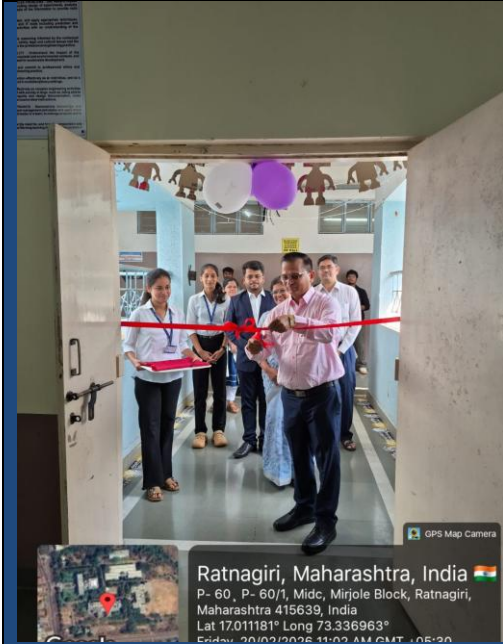
TechSpring 2026

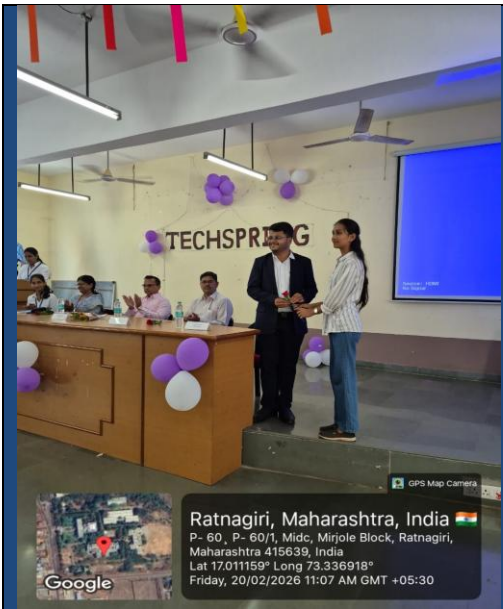

Technical Events:

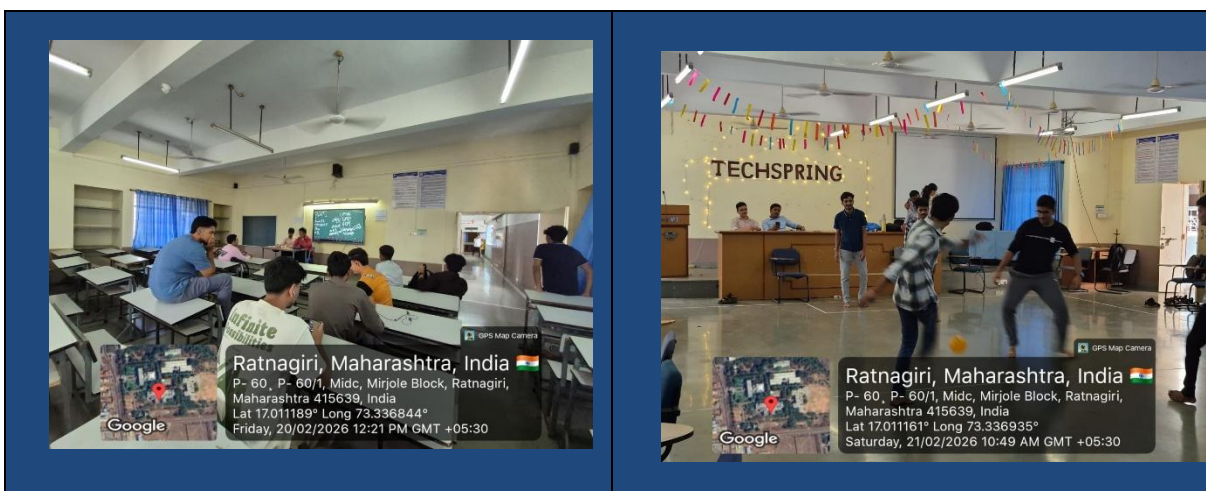
- **Technical Quiz** A knowledge-based competition where participants answer questions related to technical subjects and current trends.

Non-Technical Events

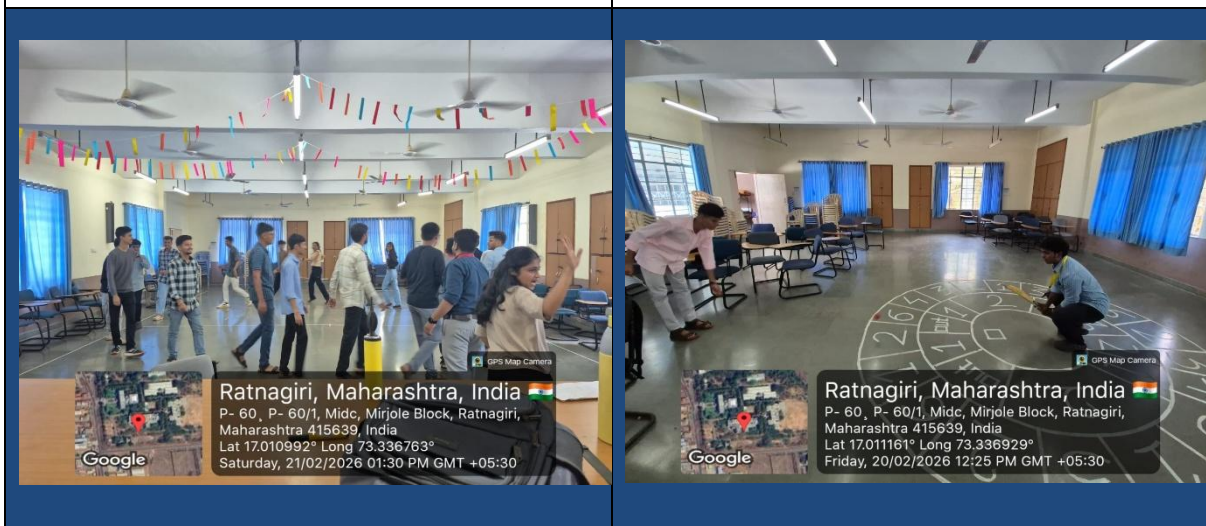
- **BGMI** A multiplayer battle royale game where players compete to survive and be the last person or team standing.
