



Two-Day Faculty Workshop On GAPC 4.0 & OBE

The workshop was organized to familiarize faculty members with the revised **Graduate Attributes and Professional Competencies (GAPC) 4.0**, Outcome-Based Education (OBE), and accreditation requirements.

The workshop featured distinguished resource persons who provided valuable insights into the implementation of GAPC 4.0 and OBE practices. 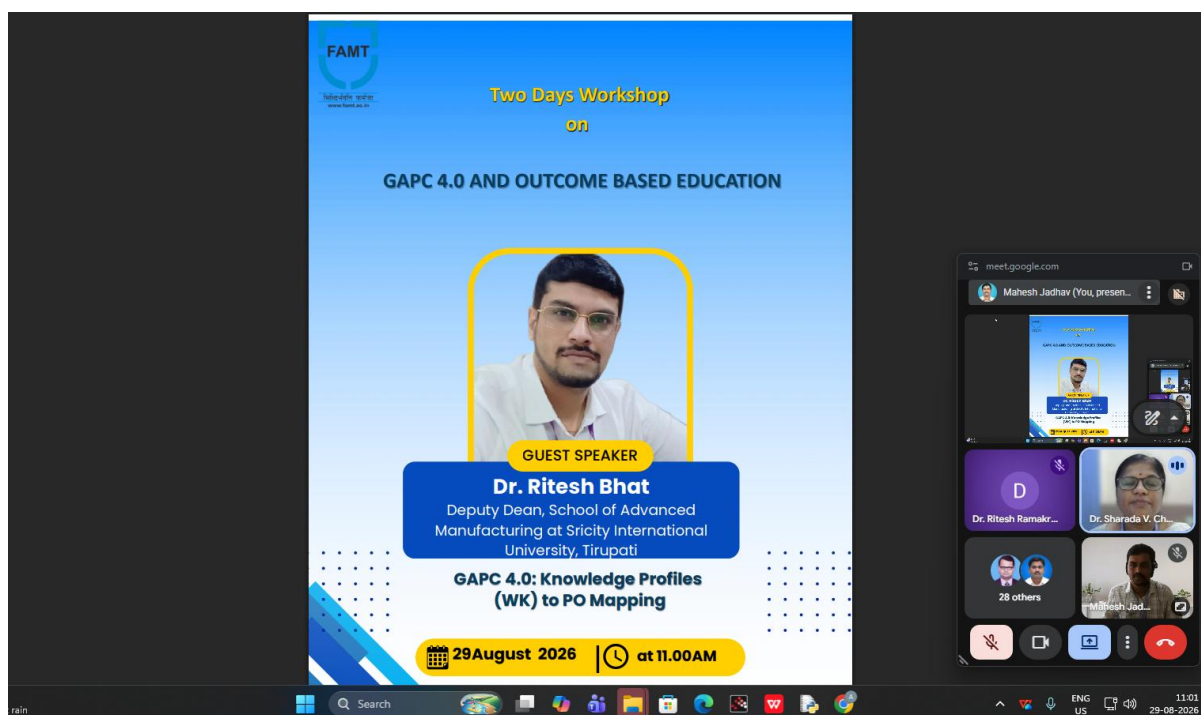
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understanding of GAPC 4.0 and its application in curriculum planning, teaching-learning processes, assessment, and accreditation documentation.

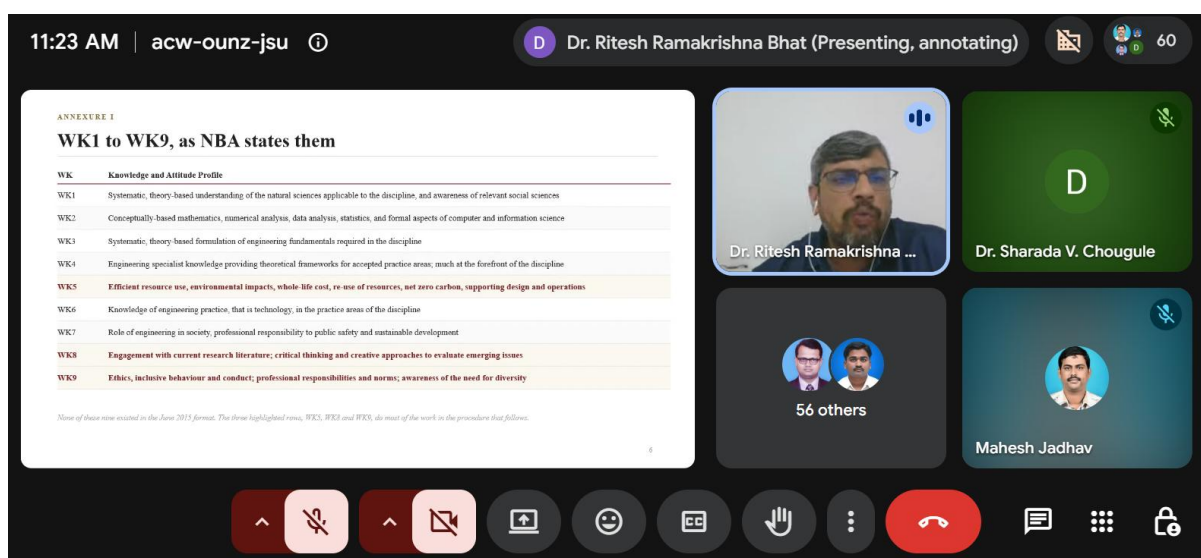

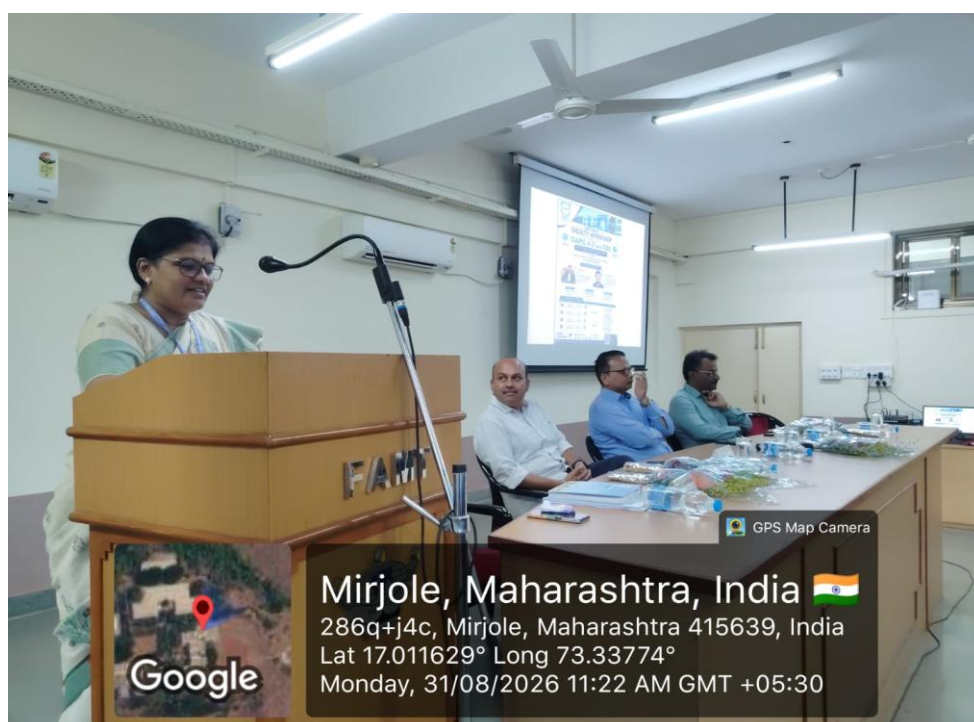
